## MONDAY 3:00-4:00

Quarter Dates: August 26, September 9, 16, 23, 30, October 7

Makey Makey with Mrs. Harbin (K4-1st Grade) (Max 10) - If you have ever dreamed of building whimsical inventions, creating interactive art, or composing electronic music look no further, Makey Makey is the class is for you! When you clip real-world things to Makey Makey, it turns the objects into keyboard keys, so you can control your computer with anything from a carrot to a bowl of water. A Makey Makey Kit is an electronic invention tool and toy that allows users to connect everyday objects to computer programs. Using a circuit board, alligator clips, and a USB cable, the toy uses closed loop electrical signals to send the computer either a keyboard stroke or mouse click signal. (Cost: \$125. \$100 for SL+ regular attendees)

SLIME TIME with Mrs. Miniard (1st-3rd Grade) (Max 10) - The students will participate in 6 interactive lessons with SLIME. They will experiment with different ingredients while learning about the color wheel, volcanoes, ocean cleanup, landforms, gravity, and will also make glow in the dark slime! We will have a fun and fascinating gooey time while making slime! (Cost: \$125. \$105 for SL+ regular attendees)

Fairytales with Mrs. Daniel (K3-2nd Grades) (Max 12) - Class will include a letter and sound focus, read aloud comprehension, literacy, math, science/social studies, fine motor, and gross motor skills. (Cost: \$100)

## WEDNESDAY 3:00-4:00

Quarter Dates: August 28, September 4, 11, 18, 25, October 2.

DINOSAURS with Mrs. Daniel (K3-2nd Grades) (Max 12) Class will include a letter and sound focus, read aloud comprehension, literacy, math, science/social studies, fine motor, and gross motor skills. (Cost: \$100)

STEM(M) Stuff with Mrs. Champagne (K5-1st Grade) (Max 10) We will be exploring structure building with pool noodles, creating and designing with puffy paints, racing and combining water droplets, making and blowing the world's strongest bubbles, discovering how to dissolve candy corn, and moving an object without touching it directly. These classes are designed to encourage hands on learning and FUN! (Cost: \$125)

MINDFUL MOVEMENT with Mrs. Coupland (3rd-5th Grades) (Max 12) Mindful Movement is a creative way to get moving while building focus, self-confidence, spontaneity and more in a fun, non-competitive environment. We will combine different types of movement like yoga poses, exercises, meditation, and mindfulness activities to learn about what mindfulness is and how it can help us calm our minds when our emotions start to get the best of us. Students will enjoy letting loose, listening to fun music, and learning about different types of movement that will challenge them and help them channel their energy into something fun and productive. (Cost: \$125. \$100 for SL+ regular attendees)

STEM(M) FUN with Mrs. McGinnis (2nd-3rd) (Max 12) Do you enjoy science? Do you like pretending to be an engineer and build things? Are you someone who thinks experimenting is exciting? Then this club is FOR YOU! Join us for a FUN afternoon of science learning! We will construct things using index cards and popsicle sticks, have a marshmallow igloo challenge, create rain clouds in a jar, make our own bubble blowers, and more! (Cost: \$120. \$100 for SL+ regular attendees)

CRAZY 8's MATH CLUB - with Mrs. Cote (3rd-5th) (Max 16) Crazy 8's is an over-the-top recreational after-school club that gets kids excited about math. You'll build glow-in-the-dark structures, crack secret spy codes, and play get-up-and-move games like Toilet Paper Olympics (just to name a few!)
