SAIS accreditation remains one of the most sought after accreditation models for high quality independent schools. The process is based on the three key components- adherence to SAIS standards, a self-study that illustrates the school's planning and how it holds itself accountable to that planning, and a visit from peers.

The accreditation process is designed to serve the needs of the school. It focuses on continuous growth and provides the opportunity to engage the entire school community in a thoughtful discussion centered on the school's unique mission.

In order to maintain compliance with SAIS accreditation standards, all accredited schools must submit reports addressing the adherence to the standards and write a narrative of the school's goals for greater and continues mission fulfillment. St. Luke's is in the process of the renewal of our accreditation. We have begun our self study in preparation for our spring visit by the SAIS team. The goals that we have listed below are the ones that we have set for our school.

Goal 1

To develop a master campus plan that addresses the current conditions and future objectives of the school.

To develop a strategic plan for making the optimal enrollment in each individual grade level as well as the whole school by the end of the year 2021.
