Students will explore a wide range of scientific disciplines through hands-on discovery—conducting experiments, creating a real sonic boom, investigating the effects of light, and diving into space science by following the Voyager 1 and Voyager 2 missions. They'll learn about electricity by generating up to 50,000 volts with a Van de Graaff Generator, then apply their knowledge by soldering and building a working circuit board—and so much more.
