Students will explore a wide range of scientific disciplines through hands-on discovery—conducting experiments, creating a real sonic boom, investigating the effects of light, and diving into space science by following the Voyager 1 and Voyager 2 missions. They'll learn about electricity by generating up to 50,000 volts with a Van de Graaff Generator, then apply their knowledge by soldering and building a working circuit board—and so much more.

Students will study, design, build, and test—through friendly competitions—cars, floating cars, hot air balloons, airplanes, and boats. Along the way, they'll explore aeronautical engineering and learn about NASA. Students will design, build, and launch straw rockets while studying solid rocket propulsion, test their engines, and, at the end of the week, construct real rockets capable of soaring up to 1,000 feet in the air.
