Re: KCOA Joanie Harper Memorial Scholarship

On behalf of the Board of Kern County Officials Association (KCOA), the KCOA Scholarship Committee would like to invite student-athletes of Kern County to apply for the 2016-2017 Joanie Harper Memorial Scholarship.

\$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to 4 student-athletes who plan to further their education past High School, who have demonstrated exceptional sportsmanship and shown themselves to be highly regarded as a teammate in their respective sport(s).

Eligibility requirements are as follows:

- Graduate from a Kern County High School that have games officiated predominately by the KCOA
- Participate in a minimum of one season of a varsity sport
- Cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher
- Attend a 2-year or 4-year College/University during the 2016-2017 academic year

Applicants must submit the following:

- 1. Completed Joanie Harper Memorial Scholarship Form
- 2. Personal statement
 - 1- 2 page paper including: academic and future goals, a narrative on "What Sportsmanship Means to Me" and why they consider themselves to have been highly regarded as a teammate.
- 3. Two letters of recommendation describing how the applicant exemplified sportsmanship and describing their interactions as a teammate
 - One letter from a coach, teacher or counselor
 - One letter from a teammate

Application must be postmarked by <u>Monday, May 1st, 2017</u>. Recipients will be notified by <u>May 9</u>, 2017 by phone. Only the recipients will be notified.
