My father died on September 9th of 2013 in a tragic accident in a van that was going toward Chimaltenango where he worked to provide life for me and my sisters.

Some months afterward my mother became very ill, due to the death of our father, and fell into a deep depression.

Today my mother looks for work, working very hard to help us get ahead. She does whatever God allows her to do, but we can't count on support from anyone, and what we have is insufficient because we are four daughters. I want to attend 9th grade.

I arise every day to help my mother and to study. I like studying, and I have many dreams of continuing to study Community Development and then later to study for a Master's Degree in the University.
