TUITION ASSISTANCE

All Saints parents pay approximately 60% of the total tuition. The additional 40% is raised through donations. All Saints is very grateful to have many donors who provide assistance through named scholarships, grants, Diocesan funds and the State Tax Credit Program. But because the school does not like to turn away a family with need, it is not enough; this year All Saints offered \$100,000 of its general funds to help cover tuition needs.

While this year's tuition needs have been met, tuition assistance is raised a year ahead. We are already working on raising the \$500,000+ that will be needed next school year.

FULL MISSION SUPPORT

Because All Saints keeps its tuition level low, tuition only meets 60% of the operating budget. While a Parish Sharing Subsidy and other fees and grants help cover the "gap," All Saints must raise general support to ensure teachers are paid and the lights are kept on. Some examples of these expenses include:

Transportation \$11,500

- gas, insurance, drivers, maintenance for two routes driven twice daily to provide transportation to/from school for Segura students, plus field trips/sports

Professional Teacher Training \$2,000

- for example: training from VCU to integrate STEM in the classroom
- Diversity Training by Matt Freeman (TMI)
- Teacher workshops on improving student skills in math, reading and writing

- New folding chairs (\$5,000)
- HVAC upgrade (\$180,000) - **HALF FUNDED!**
- 14-passenger bus (\$51,000) - **HALF FUNDED!**

SUSTAINABILITY GOALS

Currently teachers pay out-of-pocket for their own re-certification. This is often as much as \$900. Re-certification is required every 5 years. Providing a small endowment which can produce revenue to help offset this expense would be extremely helpful to teachers on a tight budget

Teacher Certification Fund \$50,000+

Last summer the school paid off its debt incurred when enrollment plummeted after the Great Recession. Having this burden lifted allows us to better plan for the future. Thanks to a bequest and robust fundraising, All Saints has created two investment funds: an "Urgent Use" Fund of \$250,000 to provide for capital and operational emergencies, and a Tuition Legacy Fund of \$150,000 that provides small scholarships. Ultimately, we will need these Funds to grow to over \$1 million each. We hope that gifts and bequests will help us meet our goals.

Urgent Use Fund & Tuition Legacy Fund grow 10% annually (\$40,000+)

Recently, All Saints launched the Legacy Society. This planned giving program will help ensure the school has the resources it needs for generations to come. To date, we have received one bequest and a handful of commitments. It is a top goal expand this program this year.
