**Humboldt High School** had another basketball milestone last night. Brian Williams Jr. scored over 1,000 points for his career. Brian will remember this game for his entire life.

Brian surpassed the 1,000-point mark with a free throw in the first half, but his memorable night was far from over.

With Humboldt trailing Highland Park 87-86 with 10 seconds remaining in the game, Brian dribbled the ball down the court and was fouled while driving to the basket with 1.6 seconds left on the clock.
