


# Change the Script Mobile Resources



The **Change the Script** opioid awareness campaign is administered by **Wheeler Clinic's Connecticut Clearinghouse** in partnership with the **Connecticut Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services**. The campaign connects individuals, families, and professionals with the resources they need to address prescription drug misuse.

Connecticut Clearinghouse is the state's premiere library and resource center for information and resources on substance use and mental health disorders, prevention and health promotion, treatment and recovery, wellness, and other related topics.
