

I-95 CORRIDOR UPDATE

BREVARD COUNTY

Financial Project Identification (FPID) Numbers:
426905-4, 458057-1, and 458345-1



BACKGROUND

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) continues to invest in transportation improvements throughout Brevard County. Working with regional partners, FDOT will begin widening Ellis Road this fall. Following a 2024 evaluation of Interstate 95 (I-95) in the county, FDOT has also developed two new I-95 projects: auxiliary lanes from Viera Boulevard to Fiske Boulevard and improvements at the I-95 and Malabar Road interchange.

ELLIS ROAD FPID No.: 426905-4

- **Construction Cost:** \$32 million
- **Construction Schedule:** Begins fall 2026

FDOT is widening 1.83 miles of Ellis Road from two to four lanes between John Rodes Boulevard and Wickham Road, adding sidewalks, buffered bike lanes, and three new traffic signals, in partnership with Brevard County, the cities of Melbourne and West Melbourne, the Space Coast Transportation Planning Organization, and Melbourne Orlando International Airport.

NEW PROJECTS

Savings from competitive construction bids has provided additional funding, allowing FDOT to dramatically accelerate these improvements.

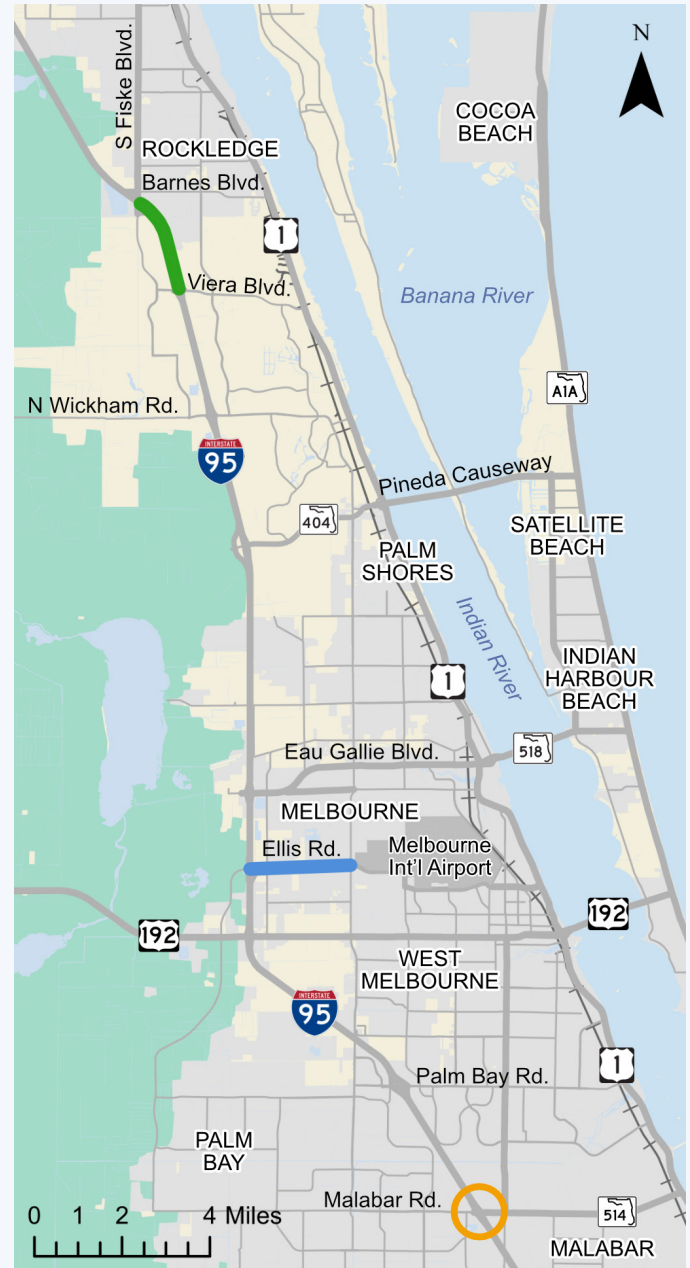
AUXILIARY LANES FPID No.: 458057-1

- **Construction Cost:** \$34.3 million
- **Construction Schedule:** Begins late 2026

In 2024, FDOT began evaluating improvements along I-95 in Brevard County. The segment between Malabar Road and Fiske Boulevard emerged as the top priority, offering the most meaningful opportunities to improve traffic flow and enhance safety. FDOT will begin with an auxiliary lane project from Viera Boulevard to Fiske Boulevard, adding one new lane in each direction, with improvements progressing southward as funding allows.

MALABAR ROAD FPID No.: 458345-1

- **Construction Cost:** \$3.9 million
 - **Construction Schedule:** Begins summer 2027
- Improvements at the I-95 and Malabar Road interchange will provide congestion relief at the busiest interchange in the City of Palm Bay. In coordination with the City, FDOT is advancing the improvements to reduce delays and prevent backups onto the I-95 mainline.
