Purpose: The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will hold a public meeting regarding project plans on U.S. 1 from Myers Drive to Crane Creek Bridge in Melbourne and Palm Bay on Tuesday, August 1, at 5:30 p.m.

The purpose of this project is to enhance safety for all modes of transportation and to resurface the corridor to extend the life of the existing roadway. Additional details are available in the attached project information handout. The public meeting is being held to present information and receive community feedback.

The Department is offering multiple ways for the community to participate in the meeting. All participants, regardless of which platform they choose, will receive the same information.

- **In-Person Open House Option:** Participants may attend in person by going to Front Street Civic Center, 2205 Front St., Melbourne, FL 32901 anytime between 5:30 p.m. and 7 p.m. to view a looping presentation and project displays, speak with project team members, and submit comments or questions. If attending in person, please remember to follow all safety and sanitation guidelines. If you are feeling unwell, please consider attending the meeting virtually or by phone.
