I will e-mail the Calves 4 Kids committee members at the end of each month with a progress report that will include the current girth (and estimated weight) of the heifer, any accomplishments or difficulties encountered and any concerns that I may have with the project.** In addition, I will keep all receipts associated with this project and maintain the record sheets provided. I will breed my heifer to a registered bull of the same breed. I realize I have the option of either returning the first qualified heifer calf to the Maine Beef Producers Association (MBPA) or purchasing the heifer for the price of \$1,000 (one thousand dollars). If I choose to return the heifer to the MBPA, I will return it at weaning, or seven months old, halter broken and with proper vaccinations: those required for the current Feeder Calf Sale Protocol.
