# Installment #8

## Cascade Yarns® 220 Superwash®

### Blanket of Many Stitches KAL

Designed by Kathy Tamer

K	= Knit	K4B - drop stitch off needle and unravel 4
KFB	= Knit in front and back of stitch	rows down, insert needle in stitch in the 5th
P	= Purl	row down
RS	= Right side	P2TOG+1 – Purl two together but do not slip
WS	= Wrong side	them from the LHN. Then purl the first stitch
		again and slip both stitches from the needle
		together

*Note: the 10 stitch border on each side is assumed in the instructions below.*

#### #22 Purl Twist (worked with color C and US 7 needles)

Preparation Row 1: Knit

Preparation Row 2: Purl

Row 1 (RS): Knit

Row 2 (WS): \*P2TOG+1; repeat from \* to marker

Row 3: Knit

Row 4: P1, \*P2TOG+1; repeat from \* to 1 stitch before marker, P1

Repeat Rows 1-4 two or three more times

Row 5: Knit

Row 6: Purl



#### #23 Ridge Knit Stitch (worked with color D and US 8 needles)

Preparation Row 1: Knit

Preparation Row 2: Purl

Row 1 (RS): Knit

Row 2: \*K2TOG; repeat from \*

Row 3: \*KFB; repeat from \*

Row 4: Purl

Repeat Rows 1-4 two more times



### #24 Bubble Stitch (worked with color A and US 7 needles)

***Note: Some knitters may prefer the alternative stitch offered on Page 3 of this installment. Read through the entire pattern and decide which stitch pattern you prefer.***

Preparation Row 1 (RS) Knit

Row 1: (WS) Purl

Row 2: (RS) Knit

Row 3: Purl

Row 4: Knit

Row 5: Purl

Row 6: \*K3, K4B; repeat from \*

Row 7: Purl

Row 8: Knit

Row 9: Purl

Row 10: Knit

Row 11: Purl

Row 12: K4B, k3; repeat from \*

Optional: repeat rows 1-12

Row 13: (after repeats), Purl Row

**Alternative Stitch Pattern for #24**

**King Charles Brocade (worked with color A and US 7 needles)**

*Note: image on this page is with color B for demonstration purposes only*

Preparation row 1: K

Preparation Row 2: P

Row 1: (RS) k1, p1, k9, p1

Row 2: p1, k1, p7, k1, p1, k1

Row 3: k1, p1, k1, p1, k5, p1, k1, p1

Row 4: (p1, k1) twice, p3, k1, p1, k1, p2

Row 5: k3, (p1, k1) three times, p1, k2

Row 6: p3, (k1, p1) twice, k1, p4

Row 7: k5, p1, k1, p1, k4

Row 8: repeat row 6

Row 9: repeat row 5

Row 10: repeat row 4

Row 11: repeat row 3

Row 12: repeat row 2

End with

Row 1: K

Row 2: P



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
