
IMPORTANT REQUEST

3rd Meal Question

Just before Reuven's mother was killed in the Holocaust, she gave him her 2 Shabbos candlesticks. They were a precious family heirloom, which had great sentimental value to him. Later, when he got married, his wife would light Shabbos candles with them each week.

Even when they went on vacation, they would bring the candlesticks with them. One time, when they returned home from vacation, Reuven was shocked to see that the precious candlesticks were not in their suitcases. All his efforts to locate them were fruitless, but he did not give up hope. He made a *neder* to give a \$1000 to charity if the missing candlesticks would be returned to him.

Eventually, one of the candlesticks was discovered, but the other remained missing. The question then arose what he should do about his vow. Should he pay the entire \$1000? OR perhaps he should just pay \$500, since only half of his loss was returned? Maybe he did not have to pay anything at all, since the condition was not completely fulfilled.




