### **3rd Meal Question**

Rivkah's father was a doctor who had a position in a hospital, and ran a private practice, where Rivkah worked as a nurse. The private practice was, well stocked, with expensive equipment and medical supplies that seemed to constantly replenish themselves without any invoices, suppliers, or shipments. Rivkah realized that her father was stealing his supplies from the hospital, but whenever she tried to subtly suggest he should not, he denied it and brushed her aside. Rivkah was torn between her obligation to honour her father on the one hand, and to protect the hospital from theft on the other. Should she go behind her father's back to warn the hospital, or would this violate the verse of "Cursed is he who strikes his father"?

A similar question was asked by a son - who worked in his father's grocery store, where people bought groceries on credit. They trusted the father to keep track of their debt. The son noticed that his father would often add to their records purchases that they never made, and charge them for it – thus stealing large amounts of money from many of his customers.

Should he keep silent to preserve his father's honour, or should he warn the customers that they are being robbed?




