# ARIEH KING ON THE DESTRUCTION OF JERUSALEM AND THE 9 DAYS

Arieh King, director and founder of the Israel Land Fund (ILF), realized the desire of Diaspora Jews to take a more active role in redeeming the land of Israel, especially in Jerusalem. Born on Kibbutz Alumim, Arieh, 38, is one of the ten original residents of Ma'ale Zeitim (Ras-Al-Amud), on the Mount of Olives.

He is the only entity working, through Israel's own legal system, to identify and restore Jewish-owned 'abandoned' (usually either in 1948 or 1967) properties to their rightful owners and is thus credited with having redeemed entire neighbourhoods of Jerusalem, such as Beit Chanina, as well as helping to 'turn the tide' in mixed Arab-Jewish cities such as Akko (Acre), and in agricultural areas of the Galil.
