3rd Meal Question

Sarah grew up with an older sister had severe mental problems and never got married. When Sarah got engaged her older sister was consumed with anger and jealousy knowing she was not likely to ever get married herself.

"I will never forgive you, unless you let me take part in your wedding too," her sister said. "I want to feel as if I were a *kallah*, to wear a *kallah* dress, to stand next to you under the chuppah, and circle the *chasan* times together with you."

Presuming that Sarah and her *chasan* could find it in their hearts to agree, and presuming that her sister would not receive a ring or a *ketubah*, would this be permitted?

On the one hand, the psychiatrist who dealt with the sister suggested that this might be soothing to her troubled mind, and helpful for her mental health. On the other hand, the Torah forbids marrying two sisters. Perhaps having two sisters standing under the chuppah together dressed like *kallahs* would be forbidden due to *maris ayin* – creating the appearance of a sin.






