



Hull Lifesaving Museum SUMMER ADVENTURE PROGRAM 2026

The Summer Adventure Program offers seven weeks of discovery and exploration for children ages 5–11. From tide pools to pond yachts and mermaids to shipwrecks, kids will explore a different theme each week!

Summer Adventure meets Tuesday–Thursday with two options: our **morning program from 9:00–12:30 (\$120 members / \$130 nonmembers)** or our **extended day from 9:00–2:30 (\$180 members / \$195 nonmembers)**. Session 1, Tide Pool Adventures I, July 7–9

A perennial summer favorite, we'll explore the fascinating tidal pools just a short walk from the museum—taking time to slow down, observe carefully, and discover the rich plant and animal life within a single small pool.

Session 2, Pirate Adventures, July 14–16

Who doesn't love a good pirate adventure! Come learn about the lives of pirates and venture on pirate outings around the museum.

Session 3, Art Week in the Yard, July 21–23

Discover the fun of maritime art projects! We will explore and foster creativity and talent each day through a variety of media, from watercolors and sidewalk chalk to sand art and collage.

Session 4, Pond Yachts Model Sailboat, July 28–30

A great opportunity for young children to build their first model boat that sails beautifully. Children will assemble, paint, and rig their vessels from a high-quality model boat kit.

Session 5, Tide Pool Adventures II, Aug 4–6

Back by popular demand, we'll return to the nearby tidal pools to look even closer at the incredible diversity of life they hold. No prior participation in Tide Pool Adventures I is required to join this session.

Session 6, Shipwrecks and Lifesavers, Aug 11–13

Walk in the footsteps of Captain Joshua James and his crew, exploring daily life at the historic Lifesaving Station. We'll learn about Boston Harbor's most amazing storms and shipwrecks, and hear stories of courageous rescues!

Session 7, Tide Pool Adventures III, Aug 18–20

Another chance to dive into one of summer's highlights, we'll continue exploring the tidal pools within easy walking distance of the museum, uncovering new details and marine life with every visit. Participation in earlier sessions is not required.
