The Summer Adventure Program offers seven weeks of discovery and exploration for children ages 5-11. From tide pools to pond yachts and mermaids to shipwrecks, kids will explore a different theme each week! Summer Adventure meets Tuesday-Thursday with two options: our regular morning program from 9:30-12:30 or extended program 9:30 - 3:00 pm with a different theme each week. Each week includes

Session 1, Pirate Adventures July 8 - 10 (\$120 members/\$130 nonmembers)

Who doesn't love a good pirate adventure! Come learn about the lives of pirates and venture on pirate outings around the museum.

Session 2, Tide Pool Adventures I, July 15 - 17 (\$120 members/\$130 nonmembers)

Always a highlight of the summer, we'll explore the wonderful tidal pools within a short walk of the museum, learning to slow down, look closely, and find the wealth of plant and animal life in a single small pool.

Session 3, Pond Yachts Model Sailboat, July 22 - July 24 (\$120 members/\$130 nonmembers)

A great opportunity for young children to build their first model boat that sails beautifully. Children will assemble, paint, and rig their vessels from a high quality model boat kit.

Session 4, Tide Pool Adventures II 29 - 31 (\$120 members/\$130 nonmembers)

Always a highlight of the summer, we'll explore the wonderful tidal pools within a short walk of the museum, learning to slow down, look closely, and find the wealth of plant and animal life in a single small pool. (It is not necessary to have participated in Tide Pool Adventures I to participate in this session).

Session 5, Art Week in the Yard, Aug 5-7 (\$120 members/\$130 nonmembers)

Discover the fun of maritime art projects! We will explore and foster creativity and talent each day through a variety of media, from watercolors and sidewalk chalk, to sand art and collage.

Session 6, Tide Pool Adventures III, Aug 12-14 (\$120 members/\$130 nonmembers)

Always a highlight of the summer, we'll explore the wonderful tidal pools within a short walk of the museum, learning to slow down, look closely, and find the wealth of plant and animal life in a single small pool. (It is not necessary to have participated in Tide Pool Adventures I or II to participate in this session).

Session 7, Shipwrecks and Lifesavers, Aug 19 - 21 (\$120 members/\$130 nonmembers)

Walk in the footsteps of Captain Joshua James and his crew, exploring daily life at the historic Lifesaving Station. We'll learn about Boston Harbor's most amazing storms and shipwrecks, and hear stories of courageous rescues!
