NEWS RELEASE

The International Bridge Administration today announced that one-way traffic crossings of the International Bridge at Sault Ste. Marie totaled 96,565 for the month of August 2025. Traffic for the calendar year-to-date on August 31, 2025, is 566,216. This represents a year-to-date decrease of 23.5% as compared to 2024. The bridge has processed 106.5 million bridge crossings since 1962.

This difference in crossings comparing 2025 to 2024 is down 31,757, which represents a decrease of 24.8.0% for the month of August.

An analysis of traffic statistics for the month reveals the following:

The International Bridge funds operational costs with toll revenue, including the bridge structure, maintenance facilities, the Bridge Authority toll plaza, and building maintenance.
