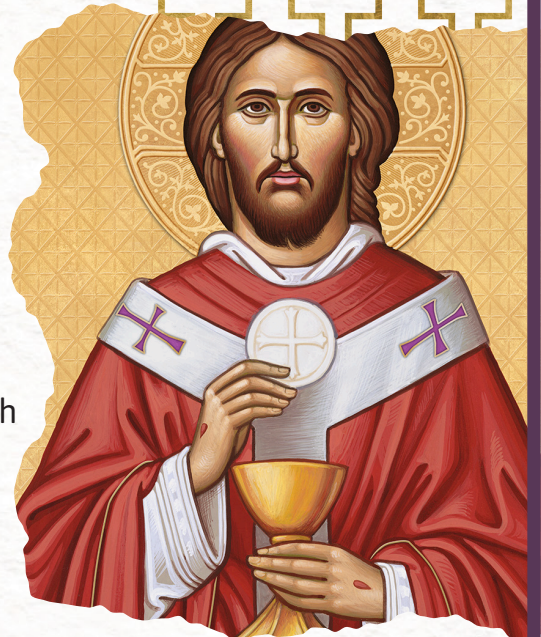
To help facilitate a deeper encounter with Jesus in the Word, we will be hosting a Worship Jesus Retreat with the theme of “The Word Becomes Flesh.” The retreat will be held at the Resch Expo on **October 11, 2022, from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.** and will feature an experience of adoration, witness talks, Mass, and keynote sessions. We are very happy to have Fr. Dave Pivonka as our retreat master for this experience.

Due to constraints regarding break-out sessions, Bishop Ricken asks priests and pastoral leaders of parishes, as well as presidents and principals of school systems, to identify no more than five parish or school leaders per mission site to attend this formation experience. All clergy serving at our parish sites and schools are welcome to attend as well. Bishop Ricken expects those who attend to participate in the full experience of the retreat, so please take this into consideration if you feel called to be a part of the day.
