

Construction Activity Notice (Extended End Date)

We are performing structural maintenance. Work will be performed that may affect your community. While progress sometimes comes with inconveniences, we will do our best to keep them to a minimum.

- Dates:** Friday, June 28 to Tuesday, September 24, 2019
- Location:** Franklin (625N - 700N) between Erie and Ontario near the Chicago Brown Line station
- Work Days/Hours:** Continuous Work (includes occasional night work)
- Work Activity:** Painting and miscellaneous repairs, including the mechanical removal of existing paint
- Impact to Residents:**
- **The 625N - 700N block of Franklin Street between Erie and Ontario will be closed to all vehicular traffic. CTA's elevated structure will be fully enclosed with tarps between Friday for the entire work period Friday, June 28 to Tuesday, September 24, 2019.**
 - The alley on Franklin between Erie and Ontario will remain open for residential alley access.
 - o 1st phase: The alley will only be accessible from the intersection of Erie and Franklin.
 - o 2nd phase: The alley will only be accessible from the intersection of Ontario and Franklin.
 - The Chicago Brown Line station will remain open during the work.
 - There will be "No Parking" on Franklin (625N - 700N), or on Erie and Ontario streets between Orleans and Wells for the duration of the work. "No Parking" signs will be posted.
 - Two-way traffic on Erie will be maintained during construction.
 - **During construction from Monday, August 5 to Friday, August 30, 2019,** Ontario will have lane reductions between Orleans and Wells.
 - There will be noise (including nighttime periods) while the work is being performed.
- Noise may include:
- o Beeping from backup alarms on construction vehicles
 - o Construction equipment traffic
 - o Flagging horns
 - o Railroad personnel communication
