STATE AND LOCAL OFFICIALS CELEBRATE THE COMMENCEMENT OF I-684 REPAVING PROJECT

Project underway to repave two miles of I-684

BEDFORD, NY -- Majority Leader Andrea Stewart-Cousins, NYSDOT Commissioner Marie Therese Dominguez, Senators Shelley Mayer and Peter Harckham, Assemblymember David Buchwald, and Bedford Town Supervisor Chris Burdick are joined by other officials to celebrate the commencement of the I-684 repaving project. The project will repave two miles of I-684 from Harris Road to Exit 6. Auxiliary roads and ramps will also be addressed, and guardrails will be evaluated and replaced where necessary. Construction on the I-684 repaving project began August 26th and is set to be complete by mid-November, weather permitting. Officials will celebrate securing the necessary funds for the repaving of I-684, discuss additional details of the project, and answer any questions from the press.
