



INDIANA WATER WELL DRILLER & PUMP INSTALLER EXAMS—April 7, 2017

The written exams for both the Indiana water well driller license and water well pump installer license will be given at the same time on Friday, April 7, 2017, in Room 14 of the Conference Center at the Indiana Government Center South (the northeast corner of West and Washington streets) in downtown Indianapolis, Indiana. The public must enter at 302 W. Washington Street. The public entrance is located at the far east end of the building, facing Senate Ave, just to the North of Washington Street.

The room will open at 1:00 p.m. and testing will begin at 1:30 p.m., EDT (local time)

Fees are collected and IDs checked before 1:30 so the exam can begin promptly. The exam typically requires between 45 and 90 minutes, though there is no time limit.

Each applicant must do the following:

- Confirm attendance (please!) by calling the Division of Water no later than Wednesday April 5, 2017.
- Pay a non-refundable exam fee of \$25.00 for each exam taken at the testing site. Make company or personal checks or money orders payable to “Department of Natural Resources,” or “DNR.” Cash will also be accepted. A company sending more than one applicant may combine exam fees in one check. Please—***do not combine*** the exam fee and the license application fee (\$100) in one check.
- Present valid photo identification, (such as a driver’s license) at the testing site.
- Bring your own pen or pencil. No other materials are needed for the test itself. The application and reference statements will be received and filed by the exam proctor if the candidate wishes to bring them, but these forms do *not* have to be completed before the exam.

The State well drilling & pump installation law and rules are the study materials. The minimum passing score on the water well driller or the pump installer exam is 70 percent. Exams will be graded the following Monday and results reported to you Tuesday. Getting Here: Maps of downtown Indianapolis and Government Center South (IGCS) are attached or enclosed. **Parking** may be available in the state parking facility between Washington & Maryland (Entry 1), in the underground museum garage one block west of IGCS (recommended), or see attached map for more information. The **testing area entry** (Room W141—the window sign says “**Conference Center**”) is on the main floor of IGCS in the west escalator lobby, to your right as you face the elevators. **Room 14** is down the hallway inside W141, first door on the left.

NOTE: Those who pass the exam have up to one year to complete the application for initial license, and provide the required references. The next scheduled exam date will be in June 16, 2017.
