## September 26 to October 1, 2021

Presbyterian Disaster Assistance and Omaha Rapid Response in partnership with Omaha's Presbyterian Church of the Cross will host a Mission Team from the Presbytery of Northern Kansas.

Bob and Rhoda Frasier will lead this team to do repair, clean up and maintenance on homes devastated by the March 2019 Nebraska flooding.

**Registration:** This trip is open to persons 18 and over, from a Presbytery of Northern Kansas ministry.

**Maximum Group size 20** Complete the registration online by August 31. As space is available persons from out of the presbytery may be accepted to participate in this mission trip. Interested persons outside of PNK are encouraged to register now and be placed on a waiting list until registrations close.

**Covid -19 Precautions:** The host site will have specific COVID-19 protocols in place that meet CDC, State, and local guidelines. In addition, **PDA requires that all volunteers provide a vaccination card** confirming that they have been fully vaccinated. Fully vaccinated is defined as receiving your final shot two weeks prior to staying at any PDA host site.

Your registration fee for this trip is \$100 per person. The Stewardship and Mission Committee covers the cost for this mission trip (group travel, accommodations, and other costs) above the registration fees collected. You will be responsible for meals on the way to Omaha or on the way home.
