I, Releasor, being of lawful age, in confederation of being permitted to participate in Releasees' marble symposium and operate power tools while performing art work under the instruction of Releasees at the symposium of Releasees above referred, do for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, hereby release and forever discharge The Marble Institute of Colorado, its administrators, employed, agents, instructors and executors and all entities and individuals identified as Releasees above, of and from any claim, demand, action or right of action of whatever kind of nature, either in law or equity, arising from or by reason of any bodily injury or personal injury known or unknown, death or property damage resulting or to result from any accident which will involve my use of power tools or any activities in connection with said activity, whether by negligence or not.

This Release contains the entire agreement between the parties hereto and the terms of this Release are contractual and not a mere recital. This Release shall be governed by the law of the State of Colorado and may be presented to any court having jurisdiction over any claim by Releasor against any or all Releasees as being a full defense thereto.

Releasor further states that she/he has carefully read the foregoing Release and knows the contents thereof and signs this Release of her/his own free act and voluntary will.
