

West Side Trail Connections

Public parks and open spaces along the Jordan River between 1300 S. and 800 S.



The proposed project implements several key components identified in the 2014 West Side Master Plan. Parks and Public Lands worked with the Glendale and Poplar Grove Community Councils to develop the initial project application.

Project Scope

The project area includes the following parks, trails, and natural areas: Jordan Park, 900 South River Park, International Peace Gardens, the Fred and Ila Fife Wetland Preserve, Three Creeks Confluence Park, Modesto Park, Bend-in-the-River Park, Jordan River Parkway Trail and the 9Line Trail.

Proposed improvements include:

- Construction of new trail segments that travel through existing parks and open spaces adjacent to the Jordan River Parkway Trail
- Removal of physical barriers including dated and unnecessary fencing
- Installation of new way-finding signage to improve park cohesion and user experience.

Project Benefits

- Integrate 80 acres of contiguous public open space between Indiana Avenue and California Avenue.
- Expand amenities that will support new recreation and event opportunities.
- Increase positive user experiences by providing new ways to use parks along the Jordan River with family & friends.
- Create new ways for users to navigate and make connections between parks along the Jordan River.
