Project Purpose:

Improve recreational infrastructure and access for Salt Lake City's meandering, tree-lined section of the Jordan River, including boat ramps and trail head improvements.

Project Scope

The Salt Lake City Water Trail Project will establish high-quality water trail access and signage along a seven-mile section of the Jordan River, creating an easy and enjoyable paddle or float only minutes away from several hundred thousand residents and major tourist centers.
