The proposed exploration center at the historic carriage house behind the Fisher Mansion on 200 South provides space for school group activities and education programs. It will also provide a place for visitors to engage with city staff and get information about the Jordan River Parkway Trail and water trail.

- Restore and rehabilitate a beautiful and irreplaceable historic community asset.
- Activate the Jordan River Parkway Trail and Folsom Trail with a “public facing” trailside amenity.

- Foster community education and appreciation of the natural history and heritage of the Jordan River.
- Provide an attractive and enjoyable destination for individuals, families and school classrooms, that facilitates hands-on learning about the natural environment and the history of the surrounding area.
