- No pencil sharpeners, scissors, mirrors, items made of glass or in glass containers, rhinestones, nail polish
- No gift certificates
- No stuffed animals
- No clothing that is blue, black, gray or orange
- No clothing for youth/adults; only clothing for infants/toddlers
- No items that promote violence
