Going forward donations need to be tailored to current needs. I spoke with Rev. Addolfo Moranta who leads the God in Action Food Alliance at Grace Church in White Plains. Grace Church provides food through their soup kitchen both to individuals in-house as well as take-out meals. Every Thursday the soup kitchen turns into a food pantry which provides food, toiletries, and household products directly to 300 individuals. If you would like to support their soup kitchen or food pantry financially, you can donate to Lifting Up Westchester on their website. CUUC has worked with Lifting Up Westchester in the past.

Currently Grace Church can no longer accept used clothes due to lack of storage space. However, new socks and new underwear for men, women, and children are much needed, as well as toiletries and household products.
