Federico Mompou's Canción y danza No. 10, has its thematic origins in the 13th-century "Cantigas de Santa Maria", assembled at the court of Alfonso el Sabio of Castile and Leon. Mompou quotes two of these Medieval melodies, the first of which likens Mary to the "Star of the day" while the second recounts Mary's miraculous healing of a woman pilgrim. The refrain tells us, "She, the Almighty and Worthy One, knows well heavenly medicine", an apt tribute in Women's History Month.
