**H.G.** has eight years' experience as a communications technician, installing and maintaining radios for the United Nations and the Afghan national army. This work included installing radio masts and towers, LAN cabling, and CCTV and PA systems. He was also involved in training new technicians in these systems. He is fluent in English. He is thoughtful and open to doing any task assigned. He is adaptable and learns new jobs quickly, both in the field and the office. He has assisted HR with timesheets and payroll. He has experience in purchasing and delivery of supplies. He also worked four years in an office summarizing audio files of news broadcasts from Afghan provinces. He's looking for a technician position with opportunities for growth.
