“Breathing Free Together” is accepting art submissions now through March 7th. All San Ramon Valley community members are welcome to submit artwork for this project. Families and groups are welcome to collaborate on pieces following County Health Guidelines.

The theme “Breathing Free Together” connects with the heart of the Black Lives Matter movement. Breathing is the most basic act of life which unites us all. Every being on earth is connected by the single act of breathing. The current pandemic also unmasked the inherent racial inequities in our systems, tying our basic survival to our individual ability to access resources and safety. The theme of “Breathing Free Together” invites us all to come together in unity to embrace racial equity, harmony, healing, and justice.

Art Exhibit Particulars:

- The Art Exhibit will consist of ten vinyl banners designed by The Art Coordinator, combining the artwork selected by the Art Selection Committee together with informative material on the theme of “Breathing Free Together.”
- The Art Selection Committee is made up of Stakeholder Representatives.
- All members of the San Ramon Valley community may submit artwork(s). Artwork submitted by Children under 13 will be selected in a separate category
- Artwork submitted by groups will be based on the age of the oldest member
- All Artwork submissions selected by the Art Selection Committee will be printed onto vinyl banners. However, artists 13 and over whose work is selected will have the option to recreate their artwork in acrylic paint directly onto a banner if they prefer. The Project Art Coordinator will be available to assist the selected artists choosing to paint directly onto a banner.
