## **Schedule –**

4:30 pm:	Teams arrive for set up
6:00 pm:	Tasting & Voting begins!
7:30 pm:	Voting ends!
7:45 pm:	Trophy Presentation

**Team Entry** – Entry fee for each team is \$50.00. Entry fee reserves a 8' space that will be assigned the day of the event and (2) admission tickets to the event. Please provide notice for power requirements when you register online.

Companies may enter multiple teams.

**Team Responsibilities** – Each team is responsible for bringing their own equipment to set up their chili cooking station. This includes but is not limited to tables, cooking equipment, extension cords, etc. The event staff will provide each team with sample size cups for tasting and disposable utensils. Each team will also be provided with a "bean jar" for voting purposes.

**Cooking Requirements** – Each team is required to provide atleast 6 quarts of chili (e.g., large crock pot). Propane cookers are also acceptable. Please keep in mind that although there is a minimum requirement of 6 quarts, no one can taste and cast votes for your chili if you run out! Each team may enter a maximum of one (1) type of chili. Teams are also allowed to provide toppings for their chili (cheese, hot sauce, saltines, etc.), but may not distribute side items or beverages.

**Voting Process** – The winning chili will be chosen by a vote of event attendees. Event attendees will be provided five (5) voting beans at admission. Attendees will place one or more voting bean(s) in the "bean jar" of their favorite entries. The team that receives the most beans at the end of the event will be awarded a custom trophy (and bragging rights for a year!) **Feel free to decorate your table, tent or booth space to attract the crowd!**
