

Ash Wednesday Service

Ash Wednesday is an important observance in the church calendar, where Christians pause to think about our own death in light of the good news of the Resurrection. Ash Wednesday begins the observance of 40 days of Lent, where we identify with Christ's sufferings and anticipate his resurrection on Easter Sunday.

This year, Ash Wednesday is on March 6, and we are again offering a meditative worship experience in the Sanctuary. There will be five prayer stations that each include a tactile prayer exercise, with instructions for children, youth, and adults so that families can participate together. You are encouraged to move through the experience at your own pace and are invited to partake in the optional imposition of ashes and communion at the end of the experience. The prayer stations will be open from 7 pm to 8:30 pm. This meditative worship experience is appropriate for children of reading age and above.
