

Two downtown projects to be unveiled at grant announcement

For immediate release (April 11, 2019) – Two Downtown Tomorrow Community Improvement Plan (DTCIP) grant recipients will unveil and present plans for their upcoming projects at a grant announcement Tuesday, April 16.

When complete, the projects will create new commercial and residential space in Orillia's downtown core. Together, the projects have an estimated construction value of more than \$890,000.

Council approved \$200,000 in funding for DTCIP in 2019. There are three intakes throughout the year and the deadline for the first intake was Feb. 28, 2019. The DTCIP review panel met in March and approved two grant applications. The amount awarded totals \$87,500 in façade, building and residential improvement grants.

The grant recipients will be at the event and available for photos and interviews.
