

Stay cool in the Sunshine City

For immediate release (July 4, 2019) – As we continue to ride this recent heat wave, the City of Orillia would like to share some ways you and your family can stay cool.

The Orillia Fire Department recommends the following tips to stay cool and hydrated during the heat wave:

- Drink plenty of water and fluids to prevent dehydration.
- Avoid strenuous outdoor activity and exercise.
- Take a cool shower or bath.
- If you go out, wear a hat and light, loose-fitting clothing.
- Keep your home cool – close curtains to block direct sunlight and use fans or an air conditioner.
- Never leave children or pets unattended in a vehicle.
- If you do not have air conditioning, visit local public buildings or shopping malls to cool off.
- Learn to recognize the signs of heat exhaustion and heat stroke.
