

## **Orillia opens cooling centres as heat wave continues**

**For immediate release (July 19, 2019)** – Due to extreme temperatures, the City of Orillia is opening three air-conditioned cooling and hydration centres for public use. The City encourages anyone – especially those susceptible to extreme heat – to make use of the centres. The cooling centres will remain open until the heat wave breaks.
