10:00 to 11:30 a.m.


January 17 to February 21, 2019

Defenses of the Enneagram types

Why learn about this particular topic? Our defense mechanism is the “enforcer” keeping us type going on automatic, and off our screen of awareness. Explore the way you (unconsciously) protect yourself when you are triggered by fear or stress and create an idealized version of yourself to present to others.

When we learn about our defense mechanism and work with it, our type structure loosens, we have more choice and the true gifts of our type can be expressed more freely. In nine different ways, we are invited to pay attention to something that is largely undercover and automatic.


