She also co-chaired the NJCAHT's Legislative Committee for 8 years, helping to get some key pieces of state legislation passed. Kate has a BA in Politics from the University of Warwick in the UK, and spent most of her working career as a BBC Radio News and Current Affairs Producer in London. Kate relocated to Tokyo with her family, where she worked for NHK - Japanese public radio and television, before moving and settling in the US.
