For 2023 the Association intends to award 2 Scholarships of \$1,000.00 each. All applicants will be notified on or about **June 1, 2023** of the Selection Committee's decision.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- All applicants **MUST** be current full-time students residing within the geographical boundary of the Borough of Morris Plains NJ.
- Applicants **MUST** be bona fide seniors in any public, private or parochial secondary schools and be a member of the current 2023 graduating class.
- Applicants must have a specific plan for the pursuit of a post high school education on a full time basis.
- Children of the Morris Plains Fire Association members are ineligible.
- Applicants will be judged on academic standing, academic achievements, school extra-curricular activities, community religious and work activities.
- Character - Applicant must have exhibited good citizenship traits and be of sound moral character.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Appropriate documentation consisting of secondary school transcripts and activity records.
- Please list in order of importance to you those extracurricular and community activities participated in, specifying length of service.
- Letter(s) of recommendation from either a guidance counselor or teacher (or both) must be provided.
- A brief statement of why you want to pursue further education or training. Please include information regarding your hobbies, work or recreational activities which you feel may be of interest to the Selection Committee.
