Professor Michael R. King is the Lansdowne Chair in Finance at University of Victoria's <u>Gustavson School of Business</u>. Prior to joining UVic, he held the Tangerine Chair in Finance at Western University's <u>Ivey Business School</u> (2011-2019), where he co-founded Canada's first FinTech research centre, the <u>Scotiabank Digital Banking Lab</u>. Before joining academia, he worked in investment banking in Zurich, New York and London from 1990-1998 (Credit Suisse, RBC Dominion Securities) and central banking in Ottawa and Basel from 2001-2011 (Bank of Canada, Bank for International Settlements). Michael has an MSc and PhD from the London School of Economics and holds the CFA designation. His research and case writing focuses on climate finance, FinTech, banking, international financial markets, and corporate finance.

Michael is an engaging speaker and a passionate educator who has worked with banks, regulators, institutional investors, government bodies, entrepreneurs, and industry associations. He is the author of <u>Fintech Explained: How Technology is Transforming Financial Services</u> (2023) and the co-editor of <u>The Technological Disruption in Financial Services: How Banks, Fintechs and Customers Win Together</u> (2020).
