You may remember Nicholas! After being diagnosed with severe OCD, Nicholas stayed at the Ronald McDonald House in Providence while enrolled in the Intensive Treatment Program at Bradley Hospital.

Two years and a global pandemic later, Nicholas shares, "I will have this challenge for the rest of my life, but, with the skills and tools I obtained at Bradley Hospital, I know that I can succeed if I put in the effort and work."
