What is it? **Make Music** is a free celebration of music around the world on June 21st. Launched in 1982 in France as the *Fête de la Musique*, it is now held on the same day in more than 1,000 cities in 120 countries.

Completely different from a typical music festival, **Make Music** is open to anyone who wants to take part. Every kind of musician — young and old, amateur and professional, of every musical persuasion — pours onto streets, parks, plazas, and porches to share their music with friends, neighbors, and strangers. All of it is free and open to the public.

In Rolla: **Make Music Rolla** will be held at the Downtown Bandshell and Festival Area and will feature performances and hands-on music activities scheduled throughout the day. Concluding with a performance by the Rolla Town Band at 7:00 p.m. at the Bandshell.

Ukulele – play alongs
Handbell Ringing ...and much more!

Performances on the stage: solo piano, singing, or other solo instruments, small groups, bands, are also welcome.
