

The Fast Track Workforce Incentive Grant is a new financial aid program for adults. The grant is designed to cover the cost of tuition and fees.

Continuing your education can bring new opportunities and make a difference in the life of your family. Whether it's your first time to enroll, or you started a degree but never finished, Fast Track can be a fresh start.

The time is now.

Visit MOFastTrack.com to complete the six application steps. Learn more about eligibility requirements online and below.

- Individuals who are 25 years or older or individuals who have not been enrolled in any school within the last two years can participate.
- The grant will serve students who have not earned a bachelor's degree and are planning to enroll part time or full time.
- Individuals who make no more than \$80,000 filing jointly, or no more than \$40,000 per year, filing any other tax status.
- Grant recipients must maintain Missouri residency and work in Missouri for three years after graduation to prevent the grant from becoming a loan that must be repaid with interest.

- 3 File the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- 4 Create a state student financial aid portal login.
