As many people know, the modern gay pride parade has its roots in protest marches of the 1970s. Throughout the 70s, the queer community in cities around the world would hold solidarity marches to mark the anniversary of the Stonewall Riots. These marches only started becoming festive events after the community in Sydney, Australia decided to turn their march into a "gay Mardi Gras" in 1978. But what most people don't know is the incredible

price this first group of revelers would have to pay. *Riot* is their story.



Beginning in 1972 and culminating with that fateful night in 1978, *Riot* centers on Lance Gowland and his group of gay and lesbian friends. Through their eyes we see queer people being harassed, beaten up, arrested, expelled, fired, and worse. We experience the heartbreak of a mother losing custody of her children, the desperation of a young man choosing to take his own life, and the crushing loneliness that

An inspiring story of courage in the face of oppression, Riot is so much more than just a queer history lesson. It perfectly mixes real-life events and the people who actually experienced them with

tender personal moments and large-scale political movements to tell a rich, full story. Often enraging but always engaging, it will both make you angry and fill you with hope. *Riot* is an emotional call to action that everyone in our community needs to see.

Opening First Friday April 5, ImageOut and Gallery Q present, *19 emerging*, our annual juried exhibition for regional college-student artists. The opening will be held from 6:00 to 9:00pm at Gallery Q, located at 100 College Avenue.

ImageOut established this annual art exhibition in 2017 with the recognition that Rochester and its surrounding area are home to several amazing university art programs. The exhibition provides opportunities for local students to gain

exhibition experience, while showcasing emerging talents in our own community. Past exhibitions have included a range of artists in terms of their experience levels and the variety of mediums displayed, including printmaking, drawing, photography, sculpture and animation.

This year the ImageOut art committee will present three cash prizes. "Our committee members are excited to jury this year's exhibition and to award prizes to strong work. We hope to encourage young artists to continue to develop their skills by providing funds to aid them in purchasing art supplies and equipment," said Jamie Allen, ImageOut board member. Call for Submissions: ImageOutWrite Volume 8

Deadline: June 15, 2019

ImageOut seeks previously unpublished fiction, non-fiction, and poetry entries for the 2019 ImageOutWrite literary journal celebrating LGBTQ authors and allies. Volume 8 (editor, Jessica Heatly) will be published during this year's 27th ImageOut Film Festival to be held October 10-20, 2019.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES:

Submissions are being accepted until June 15, 2019. Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer, or Straight-Ally authors are encouraged to submit original literary work (fiction/non-fiction limit: 8,000 words; poetry limit: 3 poems/500 total words max). Submissions should seek to capture some aspect of LGBTQ lives. Send electronic submissions only (.doc, .docx, .rtf, or .txt file attached to email) in 12 pt, double-spaced font, to OutWrite@imageout.org. Submissions should include a separate cover sheet with author's name, street address, email, title of submission, and author bio (50 words max). There is no fee to submit original work. Rights revert to author after publication. Authors whose work is selected for publication will be notified by August 2, 2019, and will receive 1 hard copy of the journal as payment.
