"The time has come to reignite our collective commitment to education." The fifth International Day of Education will be celebrated on 24 January 2023 under the theme **"to invest in people, prioritize education"**. Building on the global momentum generated by the UN Transforming Education Summit in September 2022, this year's Day will call for maintaining strong political mobilization around education. Education must be prioritized to accelerate progress towards all the Sustainable Development Goals against the backdrop of a global recession, growing inequalities and the climate crisis.



This year's International Day of Education will be a platform to showcase the most important transformations that have to be nurtured to realize everyone's fundamental right to education and build a more sustainable, inclusive and peaceful futures. UNESCO's global Futures of Education report, calls us to transform the future with an urgent rebalancing of our relationships with each other, with nature as well as with technology. It will generate debate around how to strengthen education as a public endeavor and common good, how to steer the digital transformation, support teachers, safeguard the planet and unlock the potential in every person to contribute to collective well-being and our shared home.
