Who: 6th through 12th graders who are girls or other minority genders

- This dropoff event is intended for current Girl Scouts as well as non-Girl Scouts.
- Current Girl Scouts can invite a non-GS friend (and get a bonus patch). Both people need register for the event.
- New Girl Scouts (not a member in 2025-2026) who join at the event will get an additional patch.
- Non-Girl Scouts can sign up for the event with or without a Girl Scout friend.
- You can register individually or as part of a troop.
- Adults can register to participate or help.

Cost: \$6 for the event. Cost includes community service fun patch (for back of sash/vest) and supplies for the activities. Any excess funds collected by this event will be used to pay for future Wake 23 teen events or donated to the Wake 23 Lifetime Membership award fund.

Supervision at the event

Adults should check in with their participants 8:45am - 9am. Please do not just drop off in the parking lot. After your youth is checked in, you can come back at pickup time.
