



CONFIRMATION CONNECTION

Confirmation classes kicked off in October with a focus on what it means to be Lutheran. We pondered Martin Luther's life and began our exploration of Luther's small catechism.

Our first stop was Baptism. We considered what makes a sacrament. And we examined Jesus' baptism in the Gospels and compared it to our own baptismal experiences finding both commonalities and differences.



We then moved on to Communion. We read both Luke's and Matthew's accounts of the Last Supper again identifying similarities and differences between the accounts and comparing them to our own experiences in Communion. Discussion also included the understanding that Communion does not just bring us together with God and Jesus, but with all the people—past, present, and future—who participate in Communion.

Next stop: the Ten Commandments.
